The Sandusky County Engineer is NOW HIRING a full-time Maintenance Worker I.

This position has an hourly rate of \$19.50/hr. During the winter season, the applicant must be able to work overtime and possibly the night shift. Benefits include paid sick and vacation time, outstanding health insurance, 11 paid holidays and being a member of the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System. After certain qualifying events, employees are eligible for vacation cash outs, personal days and longevity pay.
