Sandusky County **Juvenile Justice Center Programs Division** is seeking a **Part-Time Program Facilitator**.

Minimum qualifications include: Completion of Associate's Degree from an accredited college in Social Work, Criminal Justice, Sociology, or Psychology preferred OR equivalent combination of education, training, and/or experience demonstrating considerable background working with troubled youth and their families. Must have two (2) years training or experience working with troubled youths and their families; working with young people in a controlled setting, youth services, criminal justice, or related field; prior experience in supervising youth; Must be 21 years of age or older at time of appointment and have the ability to establish mature rapport with juveniles.

Licensure or certification requirements: Must possess a valid Ohio Driver's License with an acceptable driving record.

Work duties include but are not limited to: Intake of youths and parents, transporting to and supervising youths at daily programming, case management, and daily written and oral communication with court staff, and outside agencies. Salary \$12.00 per hour and up to 35 hours per week.
