Position Opening

- Position:** Multi-County WLEB position Opening
This is a full time grant-funded position, subject to a 6 month probationary period. This position will be under the administrative supervision of the Sandusky County SWCD Board of Supervisors and the day to day supervision of the Office Manager. This position is housed in the Sandusky SWCD. Candidate will work in the Sandusky, Ottawa and Wood Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) County offices. The position is funded under a State Grant Program for the Western Lake Erie Basin (WLEB) through 2020, with possible further extensions.

- Duties:** This position will include working with producers, developing, preparing and writing Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plans (CNMPs) under Senate Bill 1. They will assist with Agriculture Pollution Abatement and Livestock Producer outreach in the three districts. They may assist landowners with other related farm bill programs. The candidate will also receive direction from the SWCD Board of Supervisors in addition to other duties as assigned.
- Salary:** Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health insurance, life insurance, Medicare, Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, vacation, comp and sick leave.
- Qualifications:** Applicants should have a background in agronomy, animal science, agri-business, natural resource management, and conservation, knowledge in environmental science or agriculture. Associates or Bachelor Degree is preferred.
Applicants should also have self-motivation, organizational skills, willingness to take direction from others, oral and written communication skills, the ability to work with landowners and the general public, provide team leadership and maintain a positive attitude to create and sustain a favorable image of the District while accomplishing the required tasks. This position will require extensive field work and the ability to travel on uneven terrain by foot. A valid Ohio driver's license is required. Computer requirements: Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint). Any knowledge in Google Earth, ARCGIS and CAD programs would be beneficial.
