

Sandusky County Soil & Water Conservation District Position Opening

Position: District Technician

Job Summary: The District Technician position is responsible for performing field and office technical duties for the Sandusky County Soil and Water Conservation District. This position will be a full time (40) hours a week with a 120 days probationary period.

Qualifications:

- Associates Degree or Higher in Agriculture/ Natural Resource Management **OR** 2 years of actual experience with surveying and design in the engineering field
- Actual farm experience, knowledge of agriculture, conservation, or drainage preferred
- Applicants should be self-motivated, have a positive attitude, and be organized
- Able to work with land owners and general public
- Proficient in Microsoft office, knowledge of Google Earth, ArcGIS, and CAD
- Valid Ohio Driver's License

Salary: Commensurate with qualifications and experience. Benefits include health insurance, life insurance, Medicare, Ohio Public Employees Retirement System, vacation, comp, and sick leave.

Duties:

- Provide technical and engineering assistance to Sandusky County residents and units of government
 - This includes: site investigations, needs assessments, preliminary engineering surveys, soil reconnaissance, design, layout and supervision of construction projects, and reporting of completed practices in accordance with Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) standards and specifications.
- Proficient in using surveying tools such as the total station
- Record field notes and design engineering plans in accordance with NRCS
 - Subsurface drainage systems, surface drainage mains and laterals, etc.
- Work with the Health Department on house lot drainage
